

EXTREME FIRE SEASON IN EFFECT

OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY FIRE REGULATIONS AS OF July 15, 2024

- **NO OPEN FIRES INCLUDING CAMPFIRES, CHARCOAL FIRES, COOKING FIRES, AND WARMING FIRES**
- **NO CHAIN SAWS**
- **NO INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINE USE, EXCEPT FOR MOTOR VEHICLES**
- **NO SMOKING**
- **NO CUTTING, GRINDING, AND WELDING OF METAL**
- **NO MOWING OF DRIED & CURED GRASS WITH POWER DRIVEN EQUIPMENT**
- **NO FIREWORKS**
- **NO USE OF EXPLODING TARGETS & TRACER AMMUNITION**
- **NO DEBRIS BURING INCLUDING BURN PILES & BURN BARRELS**
- **USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES, INCLUDING MOTORCYCLES AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES (ATVS), IS PROHIBITED BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 12PM – 8PM.**
- **USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES, INCLUDING MOTOCYCLES AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES (ATVS), ARE ONLY PERMITTED ON MERA’S DESIGNATED ROADS AND TRAILS THAT ARE FREE OF FLAMABLE VEGETATION. ALL OFF-ROAD TRAVEL IS PROHIBITED.**

ALL OTHER ROADS AND TRAILS ARE CLOSED TO MOTORIZED USE

- **POSSESSION OF FIREFIGHTING EQUIPMENT IS REQUIRED WHILE TRAVELING:**
 - 1. ONE SHOVEL**
 - 2. ONE 2 ½ POUND FIRE EXTINGUISHER OR LARGER**
